

# Quick Installation Guide

Default Values:

**IP-Address: 192.168.1.1**  
**Username & Password: admin**

Assign your PC an IP address by subnet 192.168.1.X (**X = 2-254**) with subnet mask 255.225.225.0

Start your browser and type the address 192.168.1.1 into the browser address field, confirm the IP address with enter.

## **CHANGE IP ADDRESS – ATTENTION PLEASE NOTE**

If you want to change the IP address of the device, Please go to **Basic Setting -> IP Setup -> VLAN-IF1**. You can add a new IP here, If you want to override the old one, please note that you check the box **Override**.

If you create a new user you have to give him a privilege level.  
0 = guest; 1-14 = operators; 15 = manager/admin

## **SAVE CONFIGURATION – ATTENTION PLEASE NOTE!**

You need to save your configuration into flash memory. Otherwise your configuration will be lost after the next reboot.

## **RESETTING THE DEVICE – ATTENTION PLEASE NOTE!**

If you want to reset the device to the factory defaults via the reset button on the front panel, press it for about ~20 seconds while the switch is running. This method will reset everything on the device except the user data.

To fully reset the device to its factory defaults you have to use a command terminal (e.g. TeraTerm or PuTTY) and connect your PC with the switches console port. (Baud rate: 115200, Data: 8bit, Parity: none, Stop: 1bit, Flow control: none)

Use the following commands after logging in to reset the device:

```
enable
```

```
clear startup-config
```

```
(Now the switch will ask you if you are sure to reset [y/n])
```

```
Press Y, then return
```

After resetting the device will save automatically the defaults.

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For your safety, be sure to read and follow all warning notices and instructions.

- Do not open the device. Opening or removing the device cover can expose you to dangerous high voltage points or other risks. Only qualified service personnel can service the device. Please contact your vendor for further information.
- Do not use your device during a thunderstorm. There may be a risk of electric shock brought about by lightning.
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
